1-28 relating to the provision of lifeguards by certain municipalities
 1-29 and counties on public beaches.

1-30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-31 SECTION 1. Section 61.065, Natural Resources Code, is
 1-32 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-33 (e) Subsection (c)(1) does not apply to a municipality with
 1-34 a population of less than 1,000 that is located in a county adjacent
 1-35 to a county with a population of more than 3.3 million.

1-36 SECTION 2. Section 61.066, Natural Resources Code, is
 1-37 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-38 (e) Subsection (b)(1) does not apply to a county adjacent to
 1-39 a county with a population of more than 3.3 million that contains a
 1-40 municipality adjacent to the Gulf of Mexico with a population of
 1-41 less than 1,000.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
