- 10 birthday; or
- 11 (2) if the child is regularly attending high school or
- 12 enrolled in a program leading toward a high school diploma or high
- 13 school equivalency certificate, the last day of the month in which
- 14 the child graduates from high school or completes a program leading
- 15 toward a high school diploma or high school equivalency
- 16 certificate.
- 17 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 264.855, Family Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 264.855. CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMANENCY CARE
- 20 ASSISTANCE BENEFITS <u>UNTIL</u> [AFTER] AGE <u>21</u> [18].
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 22 permanency care assistance agreement entered into on or after the
- 23 effective date of this Act. A permanency care assistance agreement
