## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the payment of permanency care assistance after a
- 3 child's 18th birthday.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 264.852, Family Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) A permanency care assistance agreement shall provide
- 8 for permanency care assistance payments until the last day of the
- 9 month of the child's 18th birthday. The department may continue to
- 10 provide permanency care assistance payments after the month in
- 11 which the child attains the age of 18 as long as the child is
- 12 regularly attending high school or enrolled in a program leading
- 13 toward a high school diploma or high school equivalency
- 14 certificate.
- 15 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 264.855, Family Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 264.855. CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMANENCY CARE
- 18 ASSISTANCE BENEFITS  $\underline{\text{UNTIL}}$  [AFTER] AGE  $\underline{21}$  [18].
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 20 permanency care assistance agreement entered into on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act. A permanency care assistance agreement
- 22 entered into before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 23 the law in effect on the date the agreement was entered into, and
- 24 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
