9	CLERKS. A district attorney shall defend an action, including an
10	action for writ of mandamus, brought against an election judge or
11	election clerk that alleges that the judge or clerk violated a
12	provision of this code while acting in the judge's or clerk's
13	official capacity in the county served by the district attorney.
14	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
15	to an action filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
16	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
