A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to cemeteries in certain municipalities and counties.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 4 SECTION 1. Section 711.008, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (g-3) and
- 6 (g-4) to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b), (f), (g), (g-1),
- 8 (g-2), (g-3), (g-4), (h), and (k), an individual, corporation,
- 9 partnership, firm, trust, or association may not establish or
- 10 operate a cemetery, or use any land for the interment of remains,
- 11 located:
- 12 (1) in or within one mile of the boundaries of a
- 13 municipality with a population of 5,000 to 25,000;
- 14 (2) in or within two miles of the boundaries of a
- 15 municipality with a population of 25,000 to 50,000;
- 16 (3) in or within three miles of the boundaries of a
- 17 municipality with a population of 50,000 to 100,000;
- 18 (4) in or within four miles of the boundaries of a
- 19 municipality with a population of 100,000 to 200,000; or
- 20 (5) in or within five miles of the boundaries of a
- 21 municipality with a population of at least 200,000.
- 22 (g-3) An individual, corporation, partnership, firm, trust,
- 23 or association may file a written application with the governing
- 24 body of a municipality to establish or use a cemetery located inside

- 1 the limits of the municipality. The governing body by ordinance
- 2 shall prescribe the information to be included in the application.
- 3 The governing body by ordinance may authorize the establishment or
- 4 use of the cemetery if the governing body determines and states in
- 5 the ordinance that the establishment or use of the cemetery does not
- 6 adversely affect public health, safety, and welfare. This
- 7 subsection applies only to a municipality that is located in:
- 8 (1) a county with a population of more than 750,000; or
- 9 (2) a county adjacent to a county with a population of
- 10 more than 750,000.
- 11 (g-4) An individual, corporation, partnership, firm, trust,
- 12 or association may file a written application with the
- 13 commissioners court of a county to establish or use a cemetery
- 14 located inside the limits of the county. The commissioners court by
- 15 order shall prescribe the information to be included in the
- 16 application. The commissioners court by order may authorize the
- 17 establishment or use of the cemetery if the commissioners court
- 18 determines and states in the order that the establishment or use of
- 19 the cemetery does not adversely affect public health, safety, and
- 20 welfare. This subsection applies only to a county:
- 21 (1) with a population of more than 750,000; or
- 22 (2) that is adjacent to a county with a population of
- 23 more than 750,000.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
