1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the placement of electric vehicle charging equipment on
 1-23 state property.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2165, Government Code, is
 1-26 amended by adding Section 2165.010 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 2165.010. PLACEMENT OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING
 1-28 EQUIPMENT ON STATE PROPERTY. (a) In this section:

1-29 (1) "Charging provider" means a person who provides to
 1-30 another person the use of electric vehicle charging equipment in a
 1-31 commercial transaction.

1-32 (2) "Electric vehicle charging equipment" means
 1-33 equipment manufactured for transferring electric energy from
 1-34 electric supply to an electric vehicle.

1-35 (3) "Metering device" means a commercial device used
 1-36 to measure electric energy transferred by electric vehicle charging
 1-37 equipment and compute the charge for the transferred energy.

1-38 (b) A state agency in charge and control of state property,
 1-39 including a state park, may enter into an agreement authorizing a
 1-40 charging provider to place and maintain electric vehicle charging
 1-41 equipment on the property.

1-42 (c) An agreement described by Subsection (b):

1-43 (1) must require the charging provider to use a
 1-44 metering device to determine the cost of electricity transferred to
 1-45 another person through electric vehicle charging equipment; and

1-46 (2) may include any other reasonable requirements on
 1-47 the use of the property.

1-48 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
