## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to change the
- 3 date of the general election for officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a-1) The governing body of a city that is intersected by
- 9 State Highway 195 and Interstate Highway 14 and that holds its
- 10 general election for officers on a uniform election date in May may,
- 11 <u>not later than December 31, 2024, change</u> the date on which it holds
- 12 its general election for officers to the uniform election date in
- 13 November. This subsection expires January 1, 2025.
- 14 (c) A home-rule city may implement a [the] change authorized
- 15 by this section [Subsection (a)] or provide for the election of all
- 16 members of the governing body at the same election through the
- 17 adoption of a resolution. The change contained in the resolution
- 18 supersedes a city charter provision that requires a different
- 19 general election date or that requires the terms of members of the
- 20 governing body to be staggered.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
