A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to certain benefits paid by the Employees Retirement
3	System of Texas.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 814, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 814.605 and 814.606 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 814.605. ONE-TIME ADJUSTMENT TO BENEFITS. (a) The

- 8 amount of a monthly service retirement benefit, disability
 9 retirement benefit, or death benefit paid under this chapter to a
 10 retiree or beneficiary for service credited in the employee class
 11 is increased to include a one-time 10 percent adjustment in
 12 accordance with this section.
- 13 (b) The board of trustees shall recompute the amount of a

 14 benefit paid monthly under this chapter by applying the 10 percent

 15 adjustment to the monthly amount otherwise required to be paid as

 16 determined in accordance with this chapter.
- Sec. 814.606. ANNUAL COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT. (a)

 Notwithstanding Section 814.605, the amount of a monthly service

 retirement benefit, disability retirement benefit, or death

 benefit paid under this chapter to a retiree or beneficiary for

 service credited in the employee class is increased to include a

 four percent annual cost-of-living adjustment in accordance with

 this section.
- (b) On January 1 of each year, the board of trustees shall

- 1 recompute the amount of a benefit paid monthly under this chapter by
- 2 applying the four percent adjustment to the monthly amount
- 3 otherwise required to be paid as determined in accordance with this
- 4 chapter.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) The Employees Retirement System of Texas
- 6 shall make a one-time supplemental payment of a retirement or death
- 7 benefit, as provided by this section.
- 8 (b) A supplemental payment is payable in January 2024, and,
- 9 to the extent practicable, on a date or dates that coincide with the
- 10 regular annuity payment payable to each eligible annuitant.
- 11 (c) The amount of the supplemental payment is equal to the
- 12 lesser of:
- 13 (1) \$2,000; or
- 14 (2) the gross amount of the regular annuity payment to
- 15 which the eligible annuitant is otherwise entitled for the month of
- 16 December 2023.
- 17 (d) The Employees Retirement System of Texas shall make
- 18 applicable tax withholding and other legally required deductions
- 19 before disbursing the supplemental payment. A supplemental payment
- 20 under this section is in addition to and not in lieu of the regular
- 21 monthly annuity payment to which the eligible annuitant is
- 22 otherwise entitled.
- (e) Subject to Subsections (f) and (g) of this section, to
- 24 be eligible for the supplemental payment, a person must be, for the
- 25 month of December 2023, an annuitant eligible to receive:
- 26 (1) a standard retirement annuity payment;
- 27 (2) an optional service retirement annuity payment as

- 1 either a retiree or beneficiary under Section 814.108, Government
- 2 Code;
- 3 (3) a standard or occupational disability retirement
- 4 annuity payment;
- 5 (4) a death benefit annuity payment under Section
- 6 814.305, Government Code; or
- 7 (5) an alternate payee annuity payment under Section
- 8 804.005, Government Code.
- 9 (f) If the annuitant is a retiree or a beneficiary under an
- 10 optional retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the
- 11 supplemental payment, the effective date of the retirement of the
- 12 member of the Employees Retirement System of Texas must have been on
- 13 or before September 1, 2022. The supplemental payment shall be made
- 14 to an alternate payee who is an annuitant under Section 804.005,
- 15 Government Code, only if the annuity payment to the alternate payee
- 16 commenced on or before September 1, 2022. The supplemental payment
- 17 is in addition to the guaranteed number of payments under Section
- 18 814.108, Government Code, and may not be counted as one of the
- 19 guaranteed monthly payments.
- 20 (g) The supplemental payment does not apply to payments
- 21 under:
- 22 (1) Section 814.103 or 814.205, Government Code,
- 23 relating to retirees or disability retirees from the elected class
- 24 of membership;
- 25 (2) a subtitle other than Subtitle B, Title 8,
- 26 Government Code, except as provided by Subsection (e)(5) of this
- 27 section; or

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- 1 (3) Section 814.304, Government Code, relating to 2 retiree survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity as
- 3 the surviving spouse of a member of the elected class.
- 4 (h) Except as provided by this section, the board of
- 5 trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall
- 6 determine the eligibility for and the amount and timing of a
- 7 supplemental payment and the manner in which the payment is made.
- 8 (i) The supplemental payment is subject solely to the
- 9 availability of appropriated funds. The supplemental payment must
- 10 comply with Section 811.006, Government Code.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 814.604, Government Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 4. Sections 814.605 and 814.606, Government Code,
- 13 as added by this Act, apply only to a monthly benefit payment made
- 14 by the Employees Retirement System of Texas on or after September 1,
- 15 2023.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
