A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to certain judicial statistics and related information

- 3 gathered by the Texas Judicial Council.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 71.035(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The council shall gather judicial statistics and other
- 8 pertinent information, including case-level information on the
- 9 <u>amount and character of the business transacted by courts</u>, from the
- 10 several state judges and other court officials of this state. In
- 11 addition, the council shall implement a monthly tracking system to
- 12 ensure accountability for counties and courts which participate in
- 13 the statewide integrated system for child support, medical support,
- 14 and dental support enforcement established under Section 231.0011,
- 15 Family Code. As a duty of office, the district clerks and county
- 16 clerks serving the affected courts shall report monthly such
- 17 information as may be required by the council, including, at a
- 18 minimum, the time required to enforce cases from date of
- 19 delinquency, from date of filing, and from date of service until
- 20 date of disposition. Such information as is necessary to complete
- 21 the report and not directly within the control of the district or
- 22 county clerk, such as date of delinquency, shall be provided to the
- 23 clerk by the child support registry or by the enforcement agency
- 24 providing Title IV-D enforcement services in the court. The

- 1 monthly report shall be transmitted to the Office of Court
- 2 Administration of the Texas Judicial System no later than the 20th
- 3 day of the month following the month reported, in such form as may
- 4 be prescribed by the Office of Court Administration, which may
- 5 include electronic data transfer. Copies of such reports shall be
- 6 maintained in the office of the appropriate district or county
- 7 clerk for a period of at least two years and shall be available to
- 8 the public for inspection and reproduction.
- 9 SECTION 2. The Texas Judicial Council shall adopt rules
- 10 necessary to implement this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
