A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to crime victims' compensation for criminally injurious 3 conduct in connection with trafficking of persons.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 56B, Code of Criminal 6 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 56B.0035 to read as 7 follows:

8 Art. 56B.0035. CRIMINALLY INJURIOUS CONDUCT. (a) For 9 purposes of this chapter, criminally injurious conduct includes the 10 solicitation or patronization of forced labor or services, 11 including sexual conduct, by any person if the solicitation or 12 patronization occurs in connection with a scheme or course of 13 conduct that constitutes the trafficking of persons.

(b) A victim of criminally injurious conduct described by
Subsection (a) is a trafficking victim for the purposes of grant
programs administered by the office of the governor.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to compensation for criminally injurious conduct occurring on or 18 after the effective date of this Act. Compensation for criminally 19 20 injurious conduct occurring before the effective date of this Act 21 is governed by the law in effect on the date the conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 22 purposes of this section, criminally injurious conduct occurred 23 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense 24

1 underlying the conduct occurred before that date.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
