- 8 Art. 56B.0035. CRIMINALLY INJURIOUS CONDUCT. (a) For
- 9 purposes of this chapter, criminally injurious conduct includes the
- 10 solicitation or patronization of forced labor or services,
- 11 including sexual conduct, by any person if the solicitation or
- 12 patronization occurs in connection with a scheme or course of
- 13 conduct that constitutes the trafficking of persons.
- 14 (b) A victim of criminally injurious conduct described by
- 15 Subsection (a) is a trafficking victim for the purposes of grant
- 16 programs administered by the office of the governor.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to compensation for criminally injurious conduct occurring on or
- 19 after the effective date of this Act. Compensation for criminally
- 20 injurious conduct occurring before the effective date of this Act
- 21 is governed by the law in effect on the date the conduct occurred,
- 22 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 23 purposes of this section, criminally injurious conduct occurred
- 24 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
