| 15 | Sec. 240.062. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A person commits an |
| 16 | offense if the person on three or more occasions violates an order |
| 17 | adopted under this subchapter. |
| 18 | (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. |
| 19 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. |
