| 8 | in which a drawing to select the winning ticket occurs 12 to 15 |
| 9 | times per hour between the hours of 7 a.m. and 2 a.m. of the |
| 10 | following day. |
| 11 | SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 466, Government Code, is |
| 12 | amended by adding Section 466.0275 to read as follows: |
| 13 | Sec. 466.0275. QUICK DRAW LOTTERY GAME; SALES AGENT LICENSE |
| 14 | FOR QUICK DRAW LOTTERY GAME. (a) The commission shall operate a |
| 15 | quick draw lottery game. The commission shall: |
| 16 | (1) determine the ticket price, payout amounts, and |
| 17 | manner in which the game is conducted; |
| 18 | (2) restrict the locations authorized to sell the |
| 19 | quick draw lottery game tickets to only locations licensed as sales |
| 20 | agents in accordance with Subsection (b); and |
| 21 | (3) ensure the game remains competitive with other |
| 22 | lottery games the commission offers. |
| 23 | (b) The commission may license as sales agents to sell quick |
| 24 | draw lottery game tickets only holders of one of the following |

| 21 | of this Act but not later than January 1, 2024, the Texas Lottery |
| 22 | Commission shall implement Section 466.0275, Government Code, as |

| 24 | issuing sales agent licenses, and establishing the quick draw |

| 26 | SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 27 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
