(a) 6 The officer training advisory committee is created. The committee 7 is composed of: 8 (1) one member of the legislature, appointed by the 9 10 governor; 11 (2) three members of the senate, appointed by the 12 lieutenant governor; and 13 (3) three members of the house of representatives, 14 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. (b) The member appointed under Subsection (a)(1) shall 15 16 serve as chair of the committee. (c) The committee shall conduct a study of the training 17 programs the commission establishes and maintains under this 18 chapter for officers who are required to hold a license as provided 19 by Section 1701.301. In conducting the study the committee shall 20 review and make recommendations regarding the school curricula, 21 examination requirements, and training programs required for a 22 23 person who seeks to become licensed as an officer. 24 (d) The committee shall meet at the call of the chair.

1 (e) Not later than December 1, 2024, the committee shall report the committee's findings and recommendations to the members 2 of the legislature. The committee's recommendations must include 3 4 ways to improve the training programs provided by the commission to persons who seek a license as an officer under this chapter. 5 6 (f) This section expires December 1, 2025. SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2023, the relevant 7 8 appointing officers shall appoint the members of the peace officer

9 training advisory committee under Section 1701.2511, Occupations 10 Code, as added by this Act.
