- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 48, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 48.116 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 48.116. ALLOTMENT FOR STUDENTS WITH INCARCERATED
- 9 PARENT. For each student who has a parent or legal guardian who has
- 10 been incarcerated in a penal institution, as defined by Section
- 11 1.07, Penal Code, during the school year for which the allotment is
- 12 provided, a school district is entitled to an annual allotment
- 13 equal to the district's basic allotment, or, if applicable, the sum
- 14 of the basic allotment and the allotment under Section 48.101 to
- 15 which the district is entitled, multiplied by 1.1.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
