- 8 Sec. 157.551. CIVIL PENALTY FOR INTERFERENCE WITH CHILD
- 9 CUSTODY ORDER. A municipality or county in this state may adopt an
- 10 ordinance or order that imposes a civil penalty of not more than
- 11 \$500 for engaging in conduct described by Section 25.03, Penal
- 12 <u>Code</u>.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
