A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the task force on racial diversity in the nursing
- 3 workforce.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. TASK FORCE ON RACIAL DIVERSITY IN NURSING
- 6 WORKFORCE. (a) A task force is established under this section to
- 7 assess and determine methods of promoting racial diversity in the
- 8 nursing workforce in this state.
- 9 (b) The nursing advisory committee established under
- 10 Section 104.0155, Health and Safety Code, shall develop a uniform
- 11 application form to use in soliciting eligible applicants for task
- 12 force membership. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 13 of this Act, the nursing advisory committee shall solicit
- 14 applicants for task force membership using the uniform application
- 15 form.
- 16 (c) The task force is composed of the following nine members
- 17 the nursing advisory committee selects from the pool of eligible
- 18 applicants:
- 19 (1) one member who serves on the nursing advisory
- 20 committee;
- 21 (2) one member who represents the Texas Center for
- 22 Nursing Workforce Studies;
- 23 (3) one member who represents the Texas Higher
- 24 Education Coordinating Board;

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- 1 (4) two members who represent initial licensure
- 2 nursing programs of public institutions of higher education in this
- 3 state;
- 4 (5) two members who represent advanced nursing
- 5 programs of public institutions of higher education in this state
- 6 or health-related institutions;
- 7 (6) one member who represents the hospital industry;
- 8 and
- 9 (7) one member who represents the Texas Nurses
- 10 Association.
- 11 (d) The member serving on the nursing advisory committee
- 12 shall chair the task force.
- 13 SECTION 2. DUTIES OF TASK FORCE. The task force established
- 14 under Section 1 of this Act shall:
- 15 (1) assess the diversity in this state's nursing
- 16 workforce based on existing data;
- 17 (2) identify any current initiatives to diversify the
- 18 nursing workforce in this state and the strengths and limitations
- 19 of those initiatives;
- 20 (3) establish goals for diversifying the nursing
- 21 workforce; and
- 22 (4) develop recommendations on strategies and
- 23 promising practices to reduce barriers and achieve those diversity
- 24 goals for the nursing workforce.
- 25 SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than September 1, 2024, the
- 26 task force established under Section 1 of this Act shall deliver a
- 27 report to the Senate Health and Human Services Committee, House

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- 1 Public Health Committee, House Higher Education Committee, and
- 2 Senate Higher Education Committee detailing the task force's
- 3 activities and recommendations.
- 4 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. The task force established under
- 5 Section 1 of this Act is abolished and this Act expires December 1,
- 6 2024.
- 7 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 8 1, 2023.
