- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1231, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1231.064 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1231.064. BIENNIAL REPORT ON STATE LENDING AND CREDIT
- 8 SUPPORT PROGRAMS. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Credit support program" means a program under
- 10 which this state guarantees or provides credit enhancements for the
- 11 debt of any public or private entity, including providing support
- 12 for interest or principal payments, in a manner that obligates this
- 13 state to pay any part of the principal or interest on that debt if
- 14 the entity defaults.
- 15 (2) "Lending program" means a program through which
- 16 state money is loaned, or otherwise provided with the expectation
- of repayment, to a public or private entity.
- 18 (b) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year,
- 19 the board shall submit to the legislature and post on the board's
- 20 Internet website a report on all lending programs and credit
- 21 support programs in this state. The report must include:
- 22 (1) the total amount of state money lent through

- 1 support programs; and
- 2 (3) for each lending program or credit support
- 3 program:
- 4 (A) the total amount of state money lent through
- 5 or debt supported by the program, as applicable;
- 6 (B) a citation to the law authorizing the
- 7 program; and
- 8 (C) a reasonable estimate of the costs of default
- 9 associated with the program, computed in accordance with
- 10 private-sector accounting standards for credit or other losses.
- 11 (c) A state agency or political subdivision of this state
- 12 shall provide to the board in the manner provided by board rule any
- 13 information necessary for the board to prepare the report required
- 14 by this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
