- 8 Sec. 263.4012. PROHIBITING DISMISSAL WHEN CHILD IS MISSING.
- 9 Notwithstanding Section 263.401, the court shall retain
- 10 jurisdiction and may not dismiss the suit as required by that
- 11 section if the court finds the child is missing from the child's
- 12 substitute care provider.
- SECTION 2. Section 263.501(g), Family Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (g) Unless the child is adopted or permanent managing
- 16 conservatorship of the child is awarded to an individual other than
- 17 the department, a [A] court required to conduct permanency hearings
- 18 for a child for whom the department has been appointed permanent
- 19 managing conservator may not dismiss a suit affecting the
- 20 parent-child relationship filed by the department regarding the
- 21 child while the child is:
- 22 (1) committed to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department
- 23 or released under the supervision of the Texas Juvenile Justice

- 1 (2) missing from the child's substitute care
- 2 provider[, unless the child is adopted or permanent managing

- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
