Section 205.303, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 205.303. ACUDETOX SPECIALIST. (a) The medical board 7 may certify a person as an acudetox specialist under this section if 8 9 the person: (1) provides to the medical board documentation that 10 11 the person: 12 (A) is a licensed social worker, licensed professional counselor, including a person licensed under Section 13 14 503.308, licensed psychologist, licensed chemical dependency counselor, licensed marriage and family therapist, licensed 15 marriage and family therapist associate, licensed vocational 16 nurse, [or] licensed registered nurse, licensed physician 17 assistant, or other licensed or certified professional approved by 18 the medical board; and 19 (B) has successfully completed a training 20 21 program in <u>auricular acudetox</u> [acupuncture detoxification] that meets or exceeds the training [guidelines] approved by the medical 22 23 board; and (2) pays a certification fee in an amount set by the 24

2 (b) An acudetox specialist may practice <u>five-point</u>
3 <u>auricular</u> acupuncture only[+

[(1)] to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the
medical board for the treatment of <u>addiction</u>, trauma, or physical,
<u>emotional</u>, or psychological stress [alcoholism, substance abuse,
or chemical dependency; and

8 [(2) under the supervision of a licensed acupuncturist
9 or physician].

10 (c) <u>An</u> [A program that includes the services of an] acudetox
11 specialist shall:

12 (1) <u>obtain informed consent from each client and</u> 13 notify each <u>client</u> [participant in the program] of the 14 qualifications of the acudetox specialist and of the procedure for 15 registering a complaint regarding the acudetox specialist with the 16 medical board; and

17 (2) keep a record of each client's name <u>and</u>[-] the date
18 the client received the acudetox specialist's services,
19 <u>accompanied by the signature and printed name</u> [and the name,
20 signature, and certification number] of the acudetox specialist.

[medical board may annually renew the] 21 (d) The certification of an acudetox specialist expires on the third 22 anniversary of the date of issuance and may be renewed before the 23 24 expiration of the certification [under this section] if the person: 25 (1)provides to the medical board documentation that: (A) the certification or license required under 26 Subsection (a)(1)(A) is in effect; and 27

(B) the person has successfully met continuing
 education requirements established by the medical board under
 Subsection (e); and

4 (2) pays a certification renewal fee in an amount set5 by the medical board.

6 (e) The medical board by rule shall establish continuing 7 education requirements for an acudetox specialist [that, at a 8 minimum, include six hours of education in the practice of acupuncture and a course in either clean needle technique or 9 <u>The</u> board 10 universal infection control precaution procedures]. shall require in rules adopted under this subsection that the 11 12 certification of an acudetox specialist may not be renewed unless the person completes at least three hours of continuing education 13 14 in the licensing period before applying for the renewal.

15 SECTION 2. Section 205.303(a), Occupations Code, as amended 16 by this Act, applies only to an application for certification or 17 renewal of certification as an acudetox specialist submitted on or 18 after the effective date of this Act. An application submitted 19 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 20 effect on the date the application was submitted, and the former law 21 is continued in effect for that purpose.
