## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the training of and the provision of acupuncture 1-20 services by an acudetox specialist. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 205.303, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-24

Sec. 205.303. ACUDETOX SPECIALIST. (a) The medical board 1-25 may certify a person as an acudetox specialist under this section if 1-26 the person:

1-27 (1)provides to the medical board documentation that 1-28 the person:

1-29 (A) is a licensed social worker, licensed professional counselor, including a person licensed under Section 1-30 1-31 503.308, licensed psychologist, licensed chemical dependency counselor, <u>licensed marriage and family therapist</u>, <u>licensed</u> <u>marriage and family therapist associate</u>, licensed vocational nurse, [<del>or</del>] licensed registered nurse, <u>licensed</u> physician 1-32 1-33 1-34 assistant, or other licensed or certified professional approved by 1-35 1-36 the medical board; and

(B) has successfully completed a training program in <u>auricular acudetox</u> [acupuncture detoxification] that (B) completed 1-37 1-38 meets or exceeds the training [guidelines] approved by the medical 1-39 1-40 board; and

pays a certification fee in an amount set by the 1-41 (2) 1-42 medical board.

1-43 (b) An acudetox specialist may practice five-point 1 - 44auricular acupuncture only[+

1-45 [(1)]to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the medical board for the treatment of <u>addiction</u>, trauma, or physical, <u>emotional</u>, or psychological stress [alcoholism, substance abuse, or chemical dependency; and 1-46 1-47 1-48

1-51 (c) An [A program that includes the services of an] acudetox 1-52 specialist shall:
