- 2 relating to commissioners court quorum requirements and voting
- 3 requirements applicable to the levying of a county tax.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 81.006(a) and (c), Local Government
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Three members of the commissioners court constitute a
- 8 quorum for conducting county business [except the levying of a
- 9 county tax].
- 10 (c) A county may not levy a tax unless at least four [three]
- 11 members of the court vote in favor of the levy.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 81.006(b), Local Government Code, is
- 13 repealed.
- 14 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 15 a vote by a commissioners court on the question of levying a tax
- 16 taken on or after the effective date of this Act. A vote by a
- 17 commissioners court on the question of levying a tax taken before
- 18 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when
- 19 the vote was taken, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
