## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to requiring coursework in economics for an associate or baccalaureate degree program at a public institution of higher 3 education. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 51.311 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 51.311. ECONOMICS. (a) In this section, "institution 8 of higher education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003. 9 (b) An institution of higher education may not award an 10 11 associate or baccalaureate degree to any person unless the person 12 has credit for at least three semester credit hours or the equivalent for a course in economics that dedicates equal time to 13 14 macroeconomics and microeconomics. SECTION 2. Section 51.311, Education Code, as added by this 15 Act, applies only to a student who enrolls in an associate or 16 baccalaureate degree program at a public institution of higher 17 education on or after January 1, 2024. 18 19

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
