- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.087, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(f) For purposes of excusing a student from attending school</u>
- 8 to observe a religious holy day under Subsection (b)(1)(A), a
- 9 school district:
- 10 (1) may not require documentation from a clergy member
- 11 or other religious leader; and
- 12 (2) shall accept a note from the student's parent or
- 13 person standing in parental relation verifying the purpose of the
- 14 student's absence.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
