15	Sec. 2102.002. OFFER OF COVERAGE REQUIRED. An insurer may
16	not deliver, issue for delivery, or renew in this state an insurance
17	policy that insures a foster home for purposes of Section 42.049,
18	Human Resources Code, unless the insurer offers the insured the
19	opportunity to purchase supplemental foster care liability
20	coverage that meets the requirements of this chapter.

Sec. 2102.003. COVERAGE REQUIREMENTS. Supplemental foster

(1) pay, on behalf of the insured, amounts the insured

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- 1 of the insured in providing care to a child placed in foster care
- 2 with the insured or an act or omission of a child placed in foster
- 3 care with the insured, to the extent those damages are not covered
- 4 by liability insurance maintained by the insured to meet the
- 5 requirements of Section 42.049, Human Resources Code, or any other
- 6 insurance maintained by the insured; and
- 7 (2) provide coverage of at least \$10,000 for each
- 8 occurrence and an aggregate coverage limit of at least \$10,000 per
- 9 year.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to an insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 12 on or after January 1, 2024. A policy delivered, issued for
- 13 delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2024, is governed by the law
- 14 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 15 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
