5	SECTION 1. Section 19.004(a), Election Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), state funds
8	disbursed under this chapter may be used only to <u>:</u>
9	(1) defray expenses of the registrar's office in
10	connection with voter registration, including additional expenses
11	related to:
12	(A) [(1)] implementation of the National Voter
13	Registration Act of 1993 <u>(52 U.S.C. Section 20501 et seq.)</u> [(42
14	U.S.C. Section 1973gg et seq.)];
15	<u>(B)</u> [(2)] complying with [the] weekly updating
16	requirements [prescribed by Section 18.063]; and
17	(C) [(3)] the employment of temporary voter
18	registration personnel for not more than 39 weeks in a state fiscal
19	year; and
20	(2) if the registrar's county has a population of less
21	than 55,000, defray the cost to the registrar's county of keeping
22	the polling places in the county open during the early voting period
23	as required under Sections 85.005(c), 85.006(e), and 85.064(d).
24	SECTION 2. Section 85.005(c), Election Code, is amended to

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1 read as follows:

Voting [In a county with a population of 55,000 or more, (c) 2 3 the voting] in a primary election or the general election for state and county officers shall be conducted at the main early voting 4 5 polling place for at least 12 consecutive hours on each weekday of the last week of the early voting period, and the voting in a 6 special election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at the 7 8 main early voting polling place for at least 12 consecutive hours on each of the last two days of the early voting period. Voting under 9 10 this subsection may not be conducted earlier than 6 a.m. or later than 10 p.m. [Voting shall be conducted in accordance with this 11 subsection in those elections in a county with a population under 12 55,000 on receipt by the early voting clerk of a written request for 13 14 the extended hours submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the 15 county. The request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 85.067. 16

17 SECTION 3. Section 85.006(e), Election Code, is amended to 18 read as follows:

19 (e) In a primary election or the general election for state and county officers [in a county with a population of 55,000 or 20 more], the early voting clerk shall order voting by personal 21 appearance at the main early voting polling place to be conducted on 22 the last Saturday of the early voting period for at least 12 23 24 consecutive hours, except that voting may not be conducted earlier than 6 a.m. or later than 10 p.m., and on the last Sunday of the 25 26 early voting period for at least six consecutive hours, except that voting may not be conducted earlier than 9 a.m. or later than 10 27

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1 p.m. [The early voting clerk shall order voting to be conducted at 2 those times in those elections in a county with a population under 3 55,000 on receipt of a written request for those hours submitted by 4 at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be 5 submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 85.007.] This 6 subsection supersedes any provision of this subchapter to the 7 extent of any conflict.

8 SECTION 4. The heading to Section 85.064, Election Code, is 9 amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 85.064. DAYS AND HOURS FOR VOTING: TEMPORARY BRANCH 11 [IN POPULOUS COUNTY].

SECTION 5. Section 85.064(d), Election Code, is amended to read as follows:

The authority authorized under Section 85.006 to order 14 (d) 15 early voting on a Saturday or Sunday may also order, in the manner prescribed by that section, early voting to be conducted on a 16 17 Saturday or Sunday at any one or more of the temporary branch polling places. In addition, the early voting clerk [of a county 18 covered by Section 85.006(e)] shall order such voting in accordance 19 with Section 85.006(e) [that subsection] at each temporary branch 20 polling place established under Section 85.062(d). 21

22 SECTION 6. Section 85.068(a), Election Code, is amended to 23 read as follows:

(a) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each
election stating any dates and the hours that voting on Saturday or
Sunday will be conducted under Section 85.064(d) [or 85.065(b)], if
the early voting clerk is a county clerk or city secretary under
