- 2 relating to the extent of a municipality's extraterritorial
- 3 jurisdiction.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 42.021(a), (b), and (d), Local
- 6 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality is
- 8 the unincorporated area that is contiguous to the corporate
- 9 boundaries of the municipality and that is located:
- 10 (1) within 250 feet [one-half mile] of those
- 11 boundaries, in the case of a municipality with fewer than 5,000
- 12 inhabitants;
- 13 (2) within 500 feet [one mile] of those boundaries, in
- 14 the case of a municipality with 5,000 to 24,999 inhabitants;
- 15 (3) within 1,000 feet [two miles] of those boundaries,
- 16 in the case of a municipality with 25,000 to 49,999 inhabitants;
- 17 (4) within one-quarter mile [3-1/2 miles] of those
- 18 boundaries, in the case of a municipality with 50,000 to 99,999
- 19 inhabitants; or
- 20 (5) within one-half mile [five miles] of those
- 21 boundaries, in the case of a municipality with 100,000 or more
- 22 inhabitants.
- 23 (b) Regardless of Subsection (a), the extraterritorial
- 24 jurisdiction of a municipality is the unincorporated area that is

- 1 contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the municipality and that
- 2 is located:
- 3 (1) within one-half mile [five miles] of those
- 4 boundaries on a barrier island; or
- 5 (2) within 500 feet [one-half mile] of those
- 6 boundaries off a barrier island.
- 7 (d) Regardless of Subsection (a), the extraterritorial
- 8 jurisdiction of a municipality is the unincorporated area that is
- 9 contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the municipality and that
- 10 is located within one-half mile [three miles] of those boundaries
- 11 if the municipality:
- 12 (1) has a population of not less than 20,000 or more
- 13 than 29,000; and
- 14 (2) is located in a county that has a population of
- 15 45,000 or more and borders the Trinity River.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.903(b), Local Government Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) The governing body of the municipality by resolution or
- 19 ordinance may adopt an extraterritorial jurisdiction for all or
- 20 part of the unincorporated area contiguous to the corporate
- 21 boundaries of the municipality and located within 500 feet [one
- 22 mile] of those boundaries. The authority granted by this section is
- 23 subject to the limitation provided by Section 26.178, Water Code.
- SECTION 3. Section 212.001(1), Local Government Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (1) "Extraterritorial jurisdiction" means a
- 27 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction as determined under

- 1 Chapter 42, except that for a municipality that has a population of
- 2 5,000 or more and is located in a county bordering the Rio Grande
- 3 River, "extraterritorial jurisdiction" means the area outside the
- 4 municipal limits but within one-half mile [five miles] of those
- 5 limits.
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 54.001(8), Water Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
