- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.003, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (1-a) "Electronic eye chart" means any computerized or
- 8 other electronic system, device, or method of displaying on an
- 9 electronic screen medically accepted and properly sized optotypes,
- 10 which may be letters, numbers, or symbols, a health care
- 11 practitioner or other person uses to assess an individual's visual
- 12 acuity. The term does not include an automated computer program
- 13 that assesses an individual's visual acuity through the
- 14 individual's interaction with the program by playing a game.
- SECTION 2. Section 36.004(b-1), Health and Safety Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (b-1) The rules must allow an individual who attends a
- 18 public or private school to be screened:
- 19 (1) using photoscreening to detect vision disorders;
- 20 and
- 21 (2) using an electronic eye chart as a substitute for a
- 22 printed eye chart to assess visual acuity.
- 23 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 24 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human

- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
