4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 105.01(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided in Sections <u>105.011,</u> 105.02, 105.03,
8	105.04, 105.08, and 105.091, no person may sell, offer for sale, or
9	deliver any liquor:
10	(1) on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas
11	Day;
12	(2) on Sunday; or
13	(3) before 10 a.m. or after 9 p.m. on any other day.
14	SECTION 2. Chapter 105, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
15	by adding Section 105.011 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 105.011. SUNDAY SALE OF LIQUOR IN CERTAIN AREAS. In an
17	area where the sale on Sunday of liquor for off-premise consumption
18	has been approved by local option election:
19	(1) the holder of a package store permit may sell,
20	offer for sale, or deliver liquor on Sunday between 10 a.m. and 9
21	<u>p.m.;</u>
22	(2) the holder of a wholesaler's permit may sell, offer
23	for sale, or deliver liquor to a retailer anytime on Sunday; and
24	(3) the holder of a local distributor's permit may

1	sell, offer for sale, or deliver liquor to a retailer on Sunday
2	between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m.
3	SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 501, Election Code, is
4	amended by adding Section 501.0351 to read as follows:
5	Sec. 501.0351. ISSUE ON SUNDAY SALE OF LIQUOR. (a) In an
6	area where the sale of liquor for off-premise consumption has been
7	legalized, a local option election may be held to prohibit or
8	legalize the sale on Sunday of liquor for off-premise consumption.
9	(b) The ballot shall be prepared to permit voting for or
10	against the issue: "The sale on Sunday of liquor for off-premise
11	consumption."
12	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
