- 6 SECTION 1. Section 191.071(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The department may adopt a policy waiving the
- 9 requirement of a fingerprint-based background check for:
- 10 (1) a person who previously submitted to a
- 11 fingerprint-based background check as a condition of licensure by a
- 12 state agency; or
- 13 (2) a person serving as a judge or justice of the
- 14 supreme court, the court of criminal appeals, a court of appeals, a
- 15 district court, a criminal district court, a constitutional county
- 16 court, a statutory county court, a justice court, or a municipal
- 17 <u>court</u>.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
