H.B. No. 1380

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to continuing education for barbers and cosmetologists on  
3 identifying and assisting victims of sexual assault, domestic  
4 violence, and human trafficking.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1603, Occupations Code, is  
7 amended by adding Section 1603.302 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 1603.302. CONTINUING EDUCATION REGARDING SEXUAL  
9 ASSAULT, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING. The commission  
10 shall adopt rules requiring a license holder to complete continuing  
11 education on identifying and assisting victims of:

- 12 (1) sexual assault;  
13 (2) domestic violence; and  
14 (3) human trafficking.

15 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date  
16 of this Act, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall  
17 adopt the rules required by Section 1603.302, Occupations Code, as  
18 added by this Act.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
