8	(A) an act by a member of a family or household

11	assault or that is a threat that reasonably places the member in

13	assault, but does not include defensive measures to protect

15	(B) abuse, as that term is defined by Sections
16	261.001(1)(A), (B), (C), (D), (E), (G), (H), (I), (J), (K), and (M),
17	Family Code, by a member of a family or household toward a child of
18	the family or household; or
19	(C) dating violence, as that term is defined by
20	Section 71.0021 [has the meaning assigned by Section 71.004(1)],
21	Family Code.
22	(7) "Household member" means an individual who[+
23	[(A) is related by consanguinity or affinity to

the victim; and

- 1 $\left[\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{(B)}}\right]$ resided in the same permanent household as
- 2 the victim at the time that the criminally injurious conduct
- 3 occurred.
- 4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to compensation for criminally injurious conduct occurring on or
- 6 after the effective date of this Act. Compensation for criminally
- 7 injurious conduct occurring before the effective date of this Act
- 8 is governed by the law in effect on the date the conduct occurred,
- 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 10 purposes of this section, criminally injurious conduct occurred
- 11 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 12 underlying the conduct occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
