## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the definitions of family violence and household member
- 3 for purposes of crime victims' compensation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Articles 56B.003(6) and (7), Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (6) "Family violence" has the meaning assigned by
- 8 Section 71.004  $[\frac{71.004(1)}{1}]$ , Family Code.
- 9 (7) "Household member" means an individual who[+
- 10 [(A) is related by consanguinity or affinity to
- 11 the victim; and
- 12  $\left[\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{)}}\right]$  resided in the same permanent household as
- 13 the victim at the time that the criminally injurious conduct
- 14 occurred.

- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to compensation for criminally injurious conduct occurring on or
- 17 after the effective date of this Act. Compensation for criminally
- 18 injurious conduct occurring before the effective date of this Act
- 19 is governed by the law in effect on the date the conduct occurred,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 21 purposes of this section, criminally injurious conduct occurred
- 22 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 23 underlying the conduct occurred before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
