- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 823, Health and Safety
- Code, is amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 CHAPTER 823. ANIMAL SHELTERS AND RELEASING AGENCIES
- SECTION 2. Section 823.001, Health and Safety Code, is 8
- amended by adding Subdivision (5) to read as follows: 9
- (5) "Releasing agency" has the meaning assigned by 10
- 11 Section 828.001.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 823.002, Health and Safety Code,
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 823.002. EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN COUNTIES, CLINICS, AND 14
- FACILITIES. Except as provided by Sections 823.003(e) and 823.010, 15
- 16 this [This] chapter does not apply to:
- (1) a county having a population of less than 75,000; 17
- 18 (2) a veterinary medicine clinic; or
- (3) a livestock commission facility. 19
- SECTION 4. The heading to Section 823.003, Health and 20
- 21 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

- SECTION 5. Section 823.003(e), Health and Safety Code, is 24

- 2 (e) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 3 Services Commission $\frac{\text{shall}}{\text{shall}}$ [may] require each person operating an
- 4 animal shelter or releasing agency to keep the records required by
- 5 Section 823.010. The executive commissioner shall require the
- 6 shelter or agency [of the date and disposition of animals in its
- 7 custody, on the maintain the records on the business premises of the
- 8 [animal] shelter or agency $[\tau]$ and to make the records available for
- 9 inspection at reasonable times.
- 10 SECTION 6. Chapter 823, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Section 823.010 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 823.010. INTAKE AND DISPOSITION RECORDS FOR ANIMAL
- 13 SHELTERS AND RELEASING AGENCIES. (a) Each animal shelter,
- 14 including a shelter operated by a municipality, or releasing agency
- 15 operated in this state shall prepare and maintain records on the
- 16 <u>intake and disposition of animals in the custody of the shelter or</u>
- 17 agency, including:
- 18 (1) the total number of live animals for which the
- 19 shelter or agency has assumed custody, categorized by species and
- 20 <u>age</u>;
- 21 (2) the reason the shelter or agency assumed custody
- 22 of an animal, including whether the animal was:
- 23 (A) surrendered by the animal's owner;
- 24 (B) surrendered by the animal's owner and the
- 25 owner requested that the animal be euthanized;
- 26 (C) impounded as a stray animal or an animal at
- 27 large;

1	(D) confiscated;	
2	(E) transferred to the shelter or agency from a	
3	<pre>location in this state;</pre>	
4	(F) transferred to the shelter or agency from a	
5	location outside this state; or	
6	(G) born in the shelter or under the care of the	
7	agency;	
8	(3) the number of animals at the shelter or agency on	
9	the last day of each month, categorized by species and age; and	
10	(4) the disposition of each animal in the custody of	
11	the shelter or agency, categorized by species and age, including	
12	whether the animal:	
13	(A) was adopted;	
14	(B) was reclaimed by the animal's owner;	
15	(C) died in the shelter or under the care of the	
16	agency;	
17	(D) was transferred from the shelter or agency;	
18	(E) was euthanized by the shelter or agency on a	
19	decision of the shelter or agency;	
20	(F) was euthanized at the owner's request;	
21	(G) was returned to the field as part of a	
22	sterilization program; or	
23	(H) was lost or stolen while in the shelter's or	
24	agency's custody.	
25	(b) In the records required by Subsection (a), an animal	
26	shelter or releasing agency must use:	
27	(1) for species, the categories of dog, cat, or other:	

- 1 and
- 2 (2) for age, the categories of up to five months or
- 3 adult.
- 4 (c) An animal shelter or releasing agency monthly shall
- 5 prepare the records required by Subsection (a).
- 6 (d) An animal shelter or releasing agency shall maintain
- 7 records prepared under Subsection (a) until at least the third
- 8 anniversary of the date the record was prepared.
- 9 (e) An animal shelter or releasing agency shall make the
- 10 records required by this section available to the public by:
- 11 (1) posting the records on the shelter's,
- 12 municipality's, or agency's Internet website; or
- 13 (2) for a shelter, municipality, or agency that does
- 14 not have an Internet website, making the records available for
- 15 inspection and copying in a form regularly maintained by the
- 16 shelter, municipality, or agency.
- 17 SECTION 7. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 an animal placed at or disposed of by an animal shelter or releasing
- 19 agency or counted in the shelter's or agency's animal total on or
- 20 after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
