5	SECTION 1. Section 6002.159, Insurance Code, is amended by

8	(b) The commissioner may not adopt a rule that excludes or
9	devalues a signed or otherwise substantially verifiable
10	certificate of training that is:
11	(1) applicable to the areas of work authorized by the
12	relevant license; and
13	(2) issued by a training program or school that is:
14	(A) nationally recognized; or
15	(B) authorized under the Occupations Code or
16	Education Code.
17	(a) The commissioner may not adopt a rule that requires more

- 18 than eight hours of [Participation in the] continuing education  $\underline{\text{for}}$
- 19 <u>any license renewal period</u> [programs is voluntary].
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
