A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to assignment of traffic citations to justices of the
3 peace in large counties.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 351, Local Government 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 351.905 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 351.905. ASSIGNMENT OF TRAFFIC CITATIONS TO JUSTICES

8 OF THE PEACE IN LARGE COUNTIES. A sheriff and each constable in a

9 county with a population of one million or more shall ensure that,

10 in each county fiscal year, each justice of the peace in the county

11 <u>is assigned, to the extent possible, an equal number of citations</u>

12 for a violation of highway law under Title 7, Transportation Code,

13 issued by county law enforcement in the county.

14 SECTION 2. Section 351.905, Local Government Code, as added 15 by this Act, applies only to a county fiscal year that begins on or

16 after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
