5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 25.902 to read as follows:

- 8 Sec. 25.902. STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARDS. A school district or open-enrollment charter school shall issue to each high 9 school student enrolled in the district or school a student 10 11 identification card that includes the student's:
- 12 (1) name;
- 13 (2) photograph; and
- 14 (3) date of birth.
- SECTION 2. Section 63.0101(a), Election Code, is amended to 15 read as follows: 16
- 17 (a) The following documentation is an acceptable form of photo identification under this chapter: 18
- 19 (1) a driver's license, election identification certificate, or personal identification card issued to the person
- 21 by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or that
- 22 expired no earlier than four years before the date of presentation;
- (2) a United States military identification card that 23
- contains the person's photograph that has not expired or that 24

- 1 expired no earlier than four years before the date of presentation;
- 2 (3) a United States citizenship certificate issued to
- 3 the person that contains the person's photograph;
- 4 (4) a United States passport book or card issued to the
- 5 person that has not expired or that expired no earlier than four
- 6 years before the date of presentation; [or]
- 7 (5) a license to carry a handgun issued to the person
- 8 by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or that
- 9 expired no earlier than four years before the date of presentation;
- 10 (6) a student identification card issued to the person
- 11 by a public or private high school or institution of higher
- 12 education that contains the person's photograph and date of birth;
- 13 or
- 14 (7) any other identification card, form, or
- 15 certificate containing the person's photograph and date of birth
- 16 <u>issued by this state</u>, an agency or political subdivision of this
- 17 state, or the United States.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 25.902, Education Code, as added by this
- 19 Act, applies beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
