16	reviewed].
17	(b) An appraisal management company registered under this
18	chapter shall keep a record of the qualifications of a person
19	conducting an examination described by Subsection (a).
20	SECTION 2. Section 1104.155, Occupations Code, is amended

22	Sec. 1104.155. PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS. An appraisal
23	management company registered under this chapter shall on a
24	periodic basis <u>examine</u> [perform an appraisal review of] the work of

3 (1) the edition of the Uniform Standards of 4 Professional Appraisal Practice in effect at the time of the 5 appraisal; or

(2) other standards prescribed by board rule.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
