4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article 45.031, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Art. 45.031. COUNSEL FOR STATE NOT PRESENT. (a) If the
8	state is not represented by counsel when the case is called for
9	trial, the justice or judge may:
10	(1) postpone the trial to a date certain;
11	(2) appoint <u>any competent attorney as</u> an attorney pro
12	tem [ <del>as provided by this code</del> ] to represent the state <u>,</u>
13	notwithstanding Article 2.07; or
14	(3) proceed to trial.
15	(b) An attorney appointed under Subsection (a) is qualified
16	to perform the duties of the office of the attorney representing the
17	state and may be paid a reasonable fee for performing those duties.
18	SECTION 2. Article 45.031, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
19	amended by this Act, applies only to a trial that begins on or after
20	the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the alleged
21	offense was committed before, on, or after that date.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
