1-27 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-28 AN ACT

1-29 relating to the applicability of the law governing the provision of
 1-30 state aid to certain local governments disproportionately affected
 1-31 by the granting of ad valorem tax relief to disabled veterans.

1-32 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-33 SECTION 1. Section 140.011(a)(2), Local Government Code, is
 1-34 amended to read as follows:

1-35 (2) "Local government" means:

1-36 (A) a municipality adjacent to a United States
 1-37 military installation; ~~and~~

1-38 (B) a county in which a United States military
 1-39 installation is wholly or partly located; and

1-40 (C) a municipality located in a county that:

1-41 (i) is described by Paragraph (B); and

1-42 (ii) has a population of:

1-43 (a) more than 370,000 but not more
 1-44 than 380,000; or

1-45 (b) more than 83,000 but not more than
 1-46 84,000.

1-47 SECTION 2. Section 140.011, Local Government Code, as
 1-48 amended by this Act, applies to the eligibility of a local
 1-49 government to apply for a disabled veteran assistance payment
 1-50 beginning with the fiscal year of the local government that ends in
 1-51 the 2023 tax year.

1-52 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
