(a) In this section: 10 11 (1) "Administrative staff member" means an individual 12 who is in a senior personnel position at an assisted living facility, including a facility administrator or manager who 13 directly supervises direct service staff members. 14 (2) "Direct service staff member" means a staff member 15 16 whose work involves extensive contact with residents, including a certified nursing assistant, nurse aide, personal care assistant, 17 home health or personal care aide, licensed practical nurse, 18 licensed vocational nurse, registered nurse, social worker, 19 activity director, licensed dietitian, physician assistant, nurse 20 practitioner, physical therapist, speech language pathologist, and 21 occupational therapist. 22 23 (3) "Staff member" means: 24 (A) a full- or part-time employee of an assisted

No. 1673 1 living facility; or 2 (B) an independent consultant, contractor, or 3 subcontractor of an assisted living facility, including an employee of the consultant, contractor, or subcontractor. 4 5 (b) This section applies only to an assisted living facility that: 6 7 (1) provides personal care services to residents with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders; and 8 9 (2) does not hold a license classified under Section 10 247.029 to provide those services. (c) An assisted living facility shall require each facility 11 12 staff member to complete training approved by the commission on Alzheimer's disease and related disorders in accordance with this 13 section. 14 15 (d) An assisted living facility shall require each direct service staff member to successfully complete four hours of 16 17 training and pass an examination on: 18 (1) Alzheimer's disease and related disorders; 19 (2) the provision of person-centered care; 20 (3) assessment and care planning; 21 (4) daily life activities of residents with 22 Alzheimer's disease or related disorders; and (5) common behaviors and communications associated 23 24 with residents with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders. (e) A direct service staff member may not provide any direct 25 26 care to a resident with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders until the staff member successfully completes the training and 27

2	(f) An assisted living facility shall require each
3	administrative staff member employed by the facility to
4	successfully complete four hours of training and pass an
5	examination on:
6	(1) the topics listed under Subsection (d);
7	(2) administrative support services related to
8	medical information management and the provision of medically

10	person-centered care, to residents with Alzheimer's disease or

No. 1673 1 staff, front desk staff, maintenance staff, and other staff members 2 with incidental but recurring contact with residents with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders, to successfully complete 3 training and pass an examination on the topics listed under 4 5 Subsections (d)(1), (2), and (5). 6 (h) An assisted living facility shall provide a certificate 7 of completion to each staff member who successfully completes the 8 training and passes the examination required under Subsection (d), (f), or (q). 9 10 (i) Each direct service staff member and administrative staff member who successfully completes the training and passes the 11 12 examination required under Subsection (d) or (f) must annually complete two hours of continuing education on best practices 13 related to the treatment of and provision of care to residents with 14 15 Alzheimer's disease or related disorders. (j) Except as provided by Subsection (k), an assisted living 16 17 facility staff member who successfully completes the training and passes the examination required under Subsection (d), (f), or (g) 18 19 and who transfers to another facility is not required to complete those requirements for the other facility. 20 21 (k) An assisted living facility may require a staff member 22 who has had a lapse of employment with facilities to which this section applies for a period of two years or more to successfully 23 24 complete the training and pass the examination required under Subsection (d), (f), or (g) even if the staff member previously 25 26 completed those requirements.

27 (1) Each assisted living facility staff member who

2	education requirements, and passes an examination required under
3	this section must maintain documentation regarding the training and
4	examination.
5	(m) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
6	to implement this section.
7	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
8	of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
9	Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
10	the changes in law made by this Act.
11	SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 247.0291, Health and
12	Safety Code, as added by this Act, an assisted living facility staff
13	member to which that section applies is not required to complete the
14	training or pass the examination required under that section until
15	September 1, 2024.
16	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
