4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 3104.002, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 3104.002. DESIGNATING POET LAUREATE, STATE <u>MUSICIANS</u>
8	[MUSICIAN], AND STATE ARTISTS. (a) The committee shall designate:
9	(1) a Texas poet laureate;
10	(2) a Texas state musician for the classical genre;
11	(3) a Texas state musician for the nonclassical genre;
12	(4) [(3)] a Texas state artist for two-dimensional
13	media; and
14	(5) [(4)] a Texas state artist for three-dimensional
15	media.
16	(b) The committee shall choose the poet laureate, state

- 19 SECTION 2. The heading to Chapter 3104, Government Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- CHAPTER 3104. POET LAUREATE, STATE MUSICIANS [MUSICIAN], STATE 21
- HISTORIAN, AND STATE ARTISTS 22
- 23 SECTION 3. The heading to Subchapter A, Chapter 3104,
- Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 24

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- 1 SUBCHAPTER A. POET LAUREATE, STATE MUSICIANS [MUSICIAN], AND STATE
- 2 ARTISTS
- 3 SECTION 4. Sections 3104.004(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 4 are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The commission shall solicit nominations from the arts
- 6 and cultural community for the poet laureate, state <u>musicians</u>
- 7 [musician], and state artists. The commission shall use the
- 8 commission's Texas Cultural & Arts Network, the media, public
- 9 meetings, newsletters, the Writer's League of Texas, and other
- 10 appropriate methods to distribute information about the nomination
- 11 process.
- 12 (c) The commission may assemble a group of artists,
- 13 musicians, writers, scholars, and other appropriate experts in the
- 14 fields of literature, music, and visual arts to:
- 15 (1) review the submissions from the nominated poets,
- 16 musicians, and artists; and
- 17 (2) provide advice and recommendations to the
- 18 commission on who should be considered for designation as poet
- 19 laureate, state <u>musicians</u> [<u>musician</u>], and state artists.
- SECTION 5. Section 3104.005, Government Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 3104.005. DESIGNATION CEREMONY. The governor and
- 23 members of the committee shall honor the persons designated as poet
- 24 laureate, state <u>musicians</u> [musician], and state artists in a
- 25 ceremony at the Capitol.
- SECTION 6. Section 3104.006, Government Code, is amended to
- 27 read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 3104.006. DURATION OF DESIGNATION. A person
- 2 designated as the poet laureate, \underline{a} [the] state musician, or a state
- 3 artist retains the designation for one year from the date of the
- 4 designation ceremony.
- 5 SECTION 7. Section 3104.007, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 3104.007. PAY AND EMOLUMENTS PROHIBITED. A person
- 8 designated as the poet laureate, \underline{a} [the] state musician, or a state
- 9 artist does not receive any pay or emolument based on that
- 10 designation.
- 11 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
