Section 825.4092(f), Government Code, as added 6 by Chapter 546 (S.B. 202), Acts of the 87th Legislature, Regular 7 Session, 2021, is amended to read as follows: 8 9 (f) A reporting employer may recover the cost [is ultimately responsible for payment] of the amounts required to be contributed 10 11 under Subsections (b) and (c) from [. The employer may not directly 12 or indirectly pass that cost on to] the retiree through payroll deduction, but only to the extent the deduction would not result in 13 14 the retiree's compensation equaling an amount that is less than the minimum salary required by Section 21.402, Education Code, if 15 16 applicable [, by imposition of a fee, or by any other means designed to recover the cost]. 17 18 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a

19 retiree of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas regardless of 20 whether the person retired from employment before, on, or after the 21 effective date of this Act.

22 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply 23 beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
