The change in law made by this Act applies to an 19 offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act and to 20 any criminal action pending on the effective date of this Act for an 21 offense committed before that effective date. A final conviction 22 23 for an offense under Section 21.11, Penal Code, that exists on the effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act. 24
