Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) A local innovation plan may not provide for the 8 9 exemption of a district designated as a district of innovation from the following provisions of this title: 10 11 (1) a state or federal requirement applicable to an 12 open-enrollment charter school operating under Subchapter D, 13 Chapter 12; 14 (2) Subchapters A, C, D, and E, Chapter 11, except that a district may be exempt from Sections 11.1511(b)(5) and (14) and 15 16 Section 11.162; (3) state curriculum and graduation requirements 17 adopted under Chapter 28; 18 19 (4) Chapter 37; and (5) [(4)] academic and financial accountability and 20 21 sanctions under Chapters 39 and 39A. SECTION 2. Section 12A.004(a), Education Code, as amended 22 23 by this Act, applies only to a local innovation plan adopted or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A local 24

1 innovation plan adopted or renewed before the effective date of 2 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the plan was 3 adopted or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for 4 that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
