7	Sec. 54.102. QUALIFICATIONS FOR DIRECTORS. To be qualified
8	to serve as a director, a person shall <u>:</u>
9	(1) be at least 18 years old <u>;</u>
10	(2) be $[\tau]$ a resident citizen of the State of Texas;
11	[,] and
12	<u>(3)</u> [either] own land subject to taxation in the
13	district [or be a qualified voter within the district].
14	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
15	affect the entitlement of a member serving immediately before the
16	effective date of this Act on the board of directors of a municipal
17	utility district operating under Chapter 54, Water Code, to
18	continue to carry out the board's functions for the remainder of the
19	member's term. The change in law applies only to a member of the
20	board of directors of such a district elected or appointed on or
21	after the effective date of this Act. This Act does not prohibit a
22	person who is a member of the board of directors of such a district
23	on the effective date of this Act from being reelected or
24	reappointed to the board if the person has the qualifications

required for a member under Section 54.102, Water Code, as amended
by this Act.
