A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the medical use of low-THC cannabis by patients with 3 certain medical conditions. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 169.001(3), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 "Low-THC cannabis" means the plant Cannabis sativa (3) L., and any part of that plant or any compound, manufacture, salt, 8 9 derivative, mixture, preparation, resin, or oil of that plant that contains not more than five [one] percent by weight of 10 11 tetrahydrocannabinols. 12 SECTION 2. Section 169.003, Occupations Code, is amended to 13 read as follows: Sec. 169.003. PRESCRIPTION OF LOW-THC CANNABIS. 14 (a) А physician described by Section 169.002 may prescribe 15 low-THC cannabis to a patient if: 16 (1) the patient is a permanent resident of the state; 17 18 the physician complies with the registration (2) requirements of Section 169.004; and 19 20 (3) the physician certifies to the department that: 21 (A) the patient is diagnosed with: 22 (i) epilepsy; 23 (ii) a seizure disorder; 24 (iii) multiple sclerosis;

No. 1805 1 (iv) spasticity; 2 (v) amyotrophic lateral sclerosis; 3 (vi) autism; 4 (vii) cancer; 5 (viii) incurable neurodegenerative an 6 disease; 7 (ix) post-traumatic stress disorder; [or] 8 (x) a condition that causes chronic pain, 9 for which a physician would otherwise prescribe an opioid; 10 (xi) a medical condition that is approved for a research program under Subchapter F, Chapter 487, Health and 11 Safety Code, and for which the patient is receiving treatment under 12 13 that program; or 14 (xii) a debilitating medical condition 15 designated by the Department of State Health Services under Subsection (b); and 16 17 (B) the physician determines the risk of the medical use of low-THC cannabis by the patient is reasonable in 18 light of the potential benefit for the patient. 19 20 (b) The Department of State Health Services by rule may 21 designate debilitating medical conditions for which a physician may prescribe low-THC cannabis under this section. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
