## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the Medicaid eligibility of certain women following a
- 3 pregnancy.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.024(1-1), Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (1-1) The commission shall continue to provide medical
- 8 assistance to a woman who is eligible for medical assistance for
- 9 pregnant women for a period of not less than 12 [six] months
- 10 following the <u>last month of the woman's pregnancy</u> [date the woman
- 11 delivers or experiences an involuntary miscarriage].
- 12 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 13 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 14 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 15 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 16 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 17 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
