13	for an event not sponsored or sanctioned by the district; and		
14	(2) the district is located in:		
15	(A) a county:		
16	$\underline{\text{(i)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(A)}}{\text{(A)}}$ ] that has a population of not more		
17	than 300,000; and		
18	$\underline{\text{(ii)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{)}}$ ] in which a component university		
19	of the University of Houston System is located; or		
20	(B) a county in which is located a facility		
21	described by Subdivision (1) within two miles of two or more		
22	stadiums with a capacity of at least 40,000 people.		
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
