| 12 | (b) The number of hours of accumulated vacation leave for |
| 13 | which an employee may be paid under a policy authorized by this |
| 14 | section may not exceed all of the employee's accumulated vacation |
| 15 | leave or 40 hours of accumulated vacation leave, whichever is less. |
| 16 | (c) If the department pays a department employee for the |
| 17 | employee's accumulated vacation leave under a policy authorized by |
| 18 | this section, the department shall: |
| 19 | (1) compute the amount of the payment by multiplying |
| 20 | the employee's hourly rate of compensation on the date the employee |
